

Figure 4 - Landscape Designations, Ancient Woodland and Recreational Routes

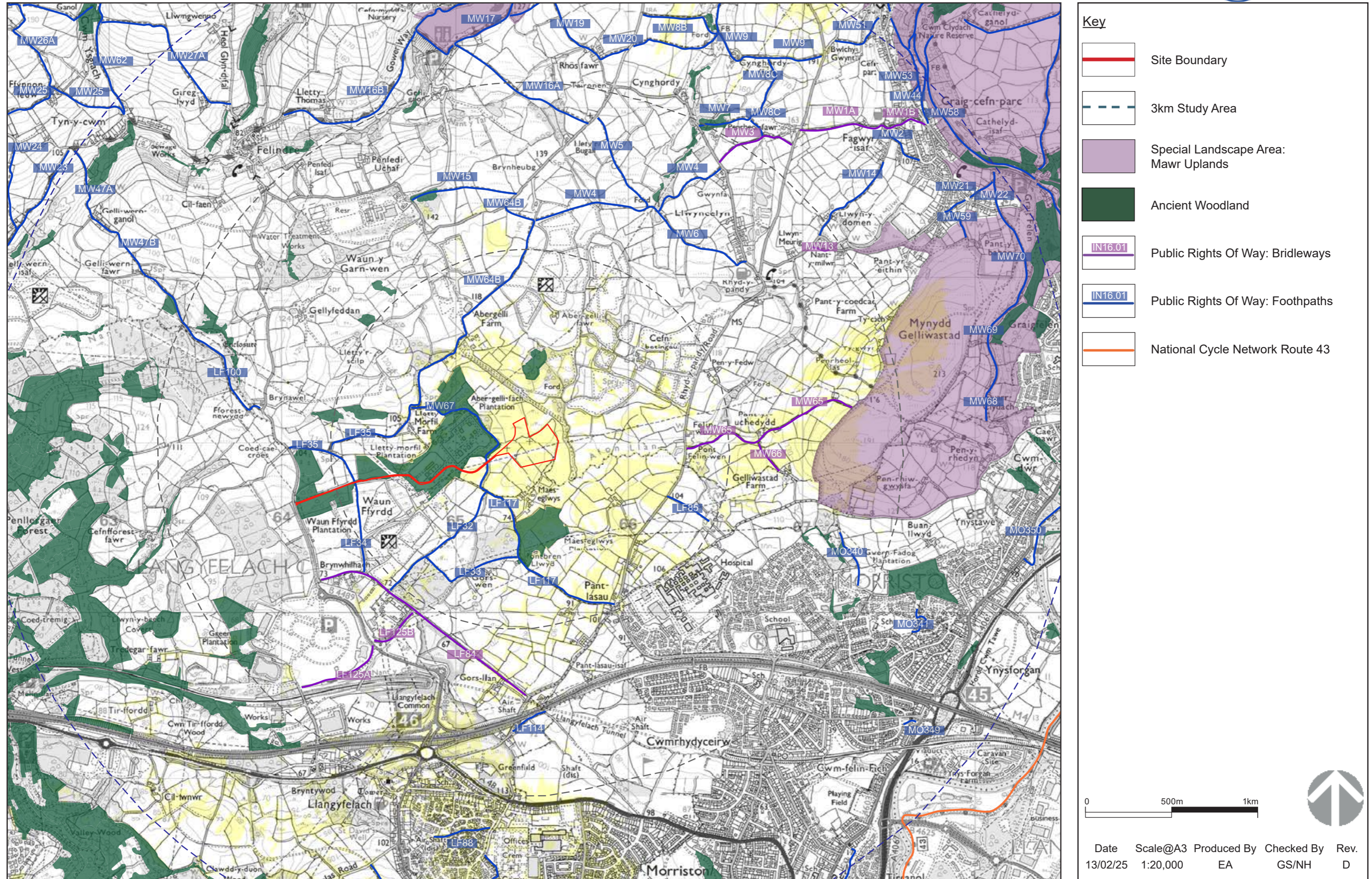
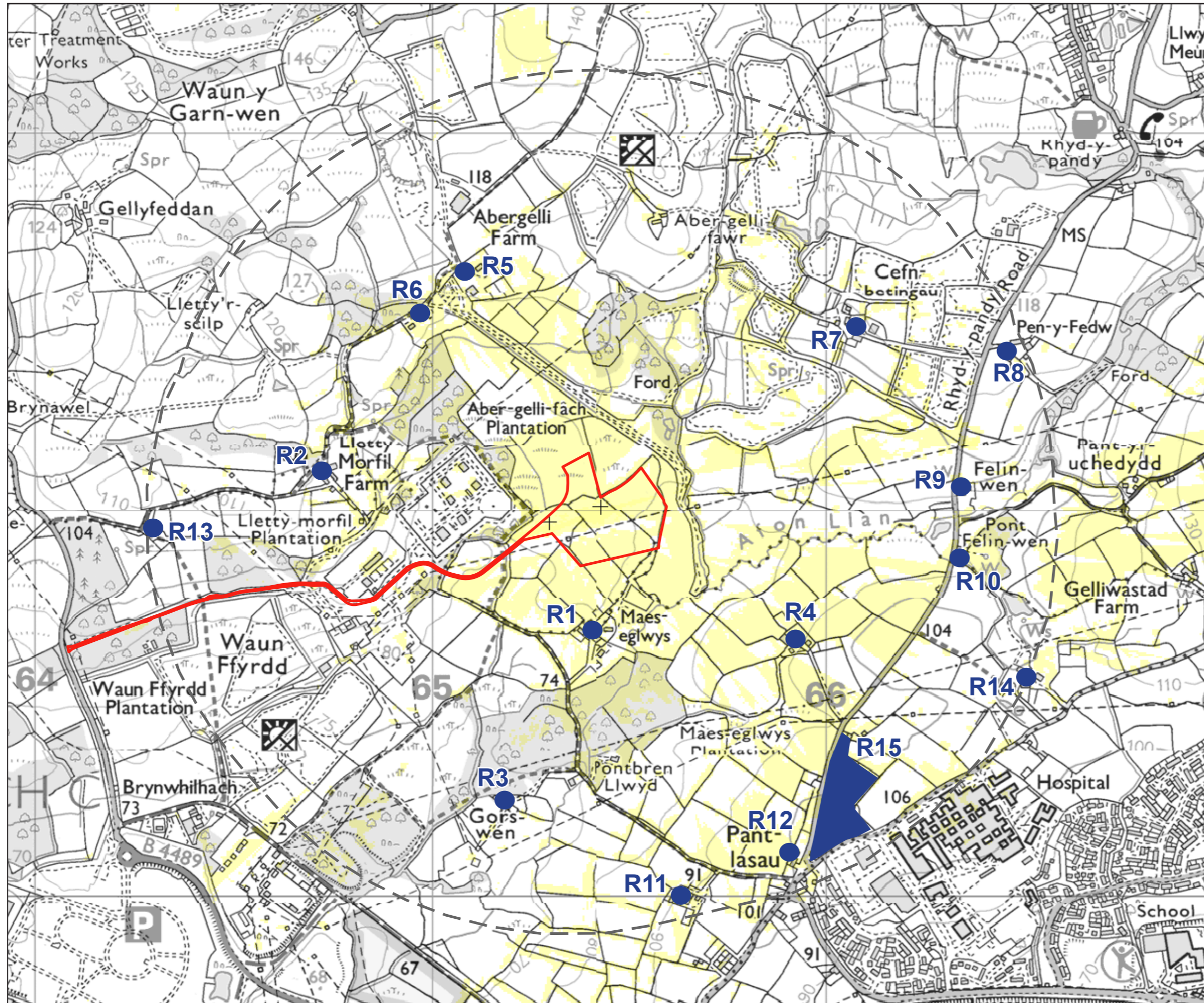


Figure 5 - Residential Receptors

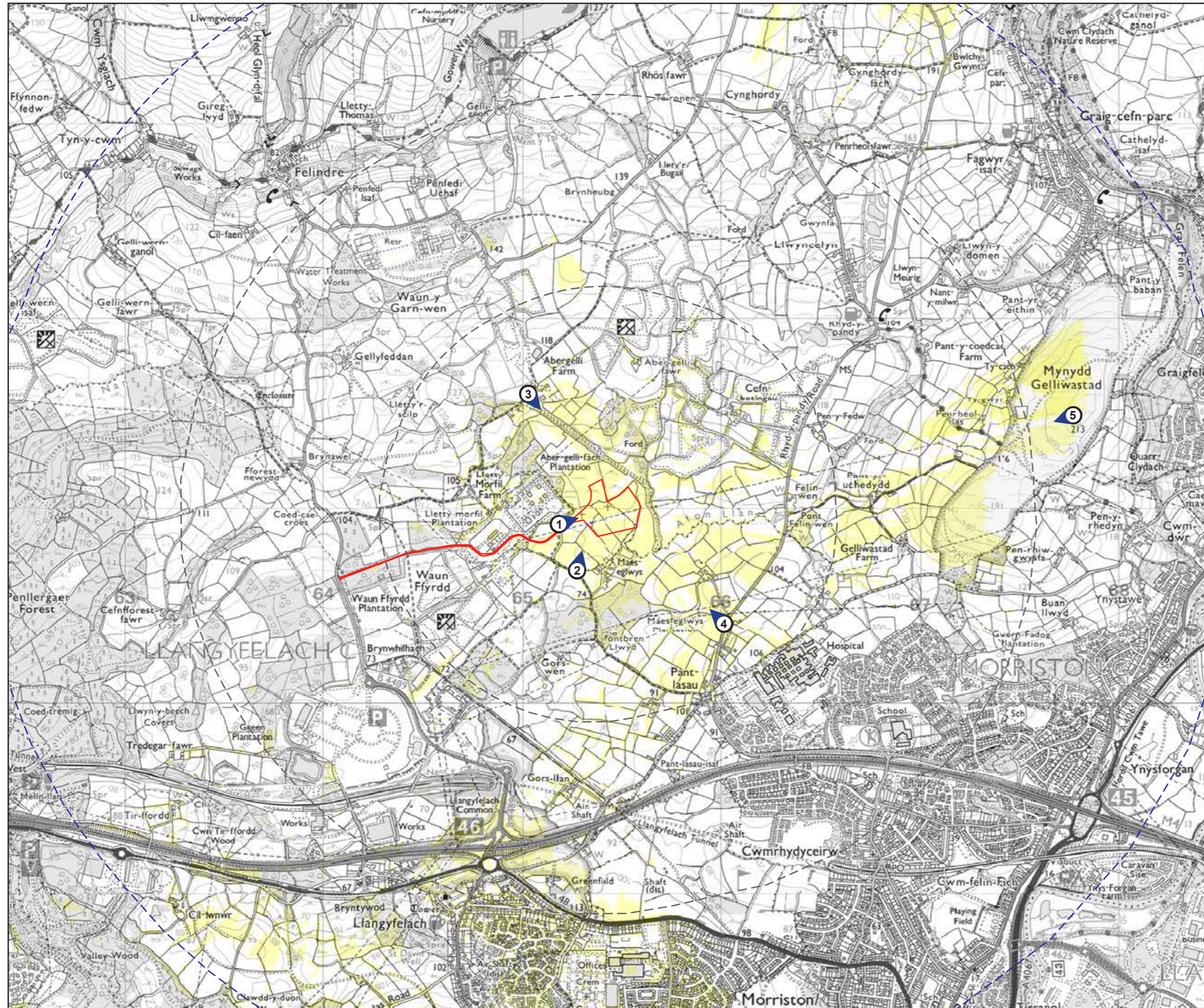


