

8 Reasons Artfield Forest is the right project for Dumfries & Galloway

1 SENSITIVE DESIGN REFLECTING FEEDBACK RECEIVED

- The number of turbines has been **reduced from 20 to 12**
- Turbines located in north of site, **further away from residential properties**
- **Easterly turbines removed** to reduce cultural heritage impact on Wood Cairn

2 PART OF THE SITE WAS PREVIOUSLY CONSENTED AS GASS WIND FARM BY D&G COUNCIL (NOW LAPSED)

Artfield Forest is in keeping with the prevailing landscape and surrounding developments.

3 Recommended for **NO OBJECTION** by Dumfries & Galloway Council's Planning Department.

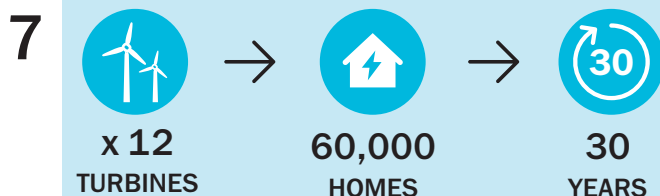
5 Majority agree Artfield Forest is an acceptable location for a wind farm
