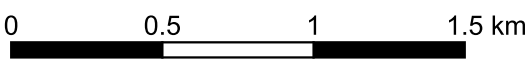


- Panorama with Wireline (90° HFOV)

Existing View
This view looks out from a long distance footpath crossing the hillside above the Gareloch. The tops of buildings at the Faslane naval base can be seen looking down towards the loch and there are views along and over the loch to the Rosneath Peninsula and the Site to the south and south-west. The Arrochar Alps and other more distant summits are visible to the north-west and west. In other direction, the views are contained by nearby rising ground.

Predicted Change
The proposed turbines would be visible in the distance mostly screened by successive layers of hills such that 3 of the turbines would be seen from just below the nacelles, and others would be seen as blade tips. It is unlikely this viewpoint would be visited at night.

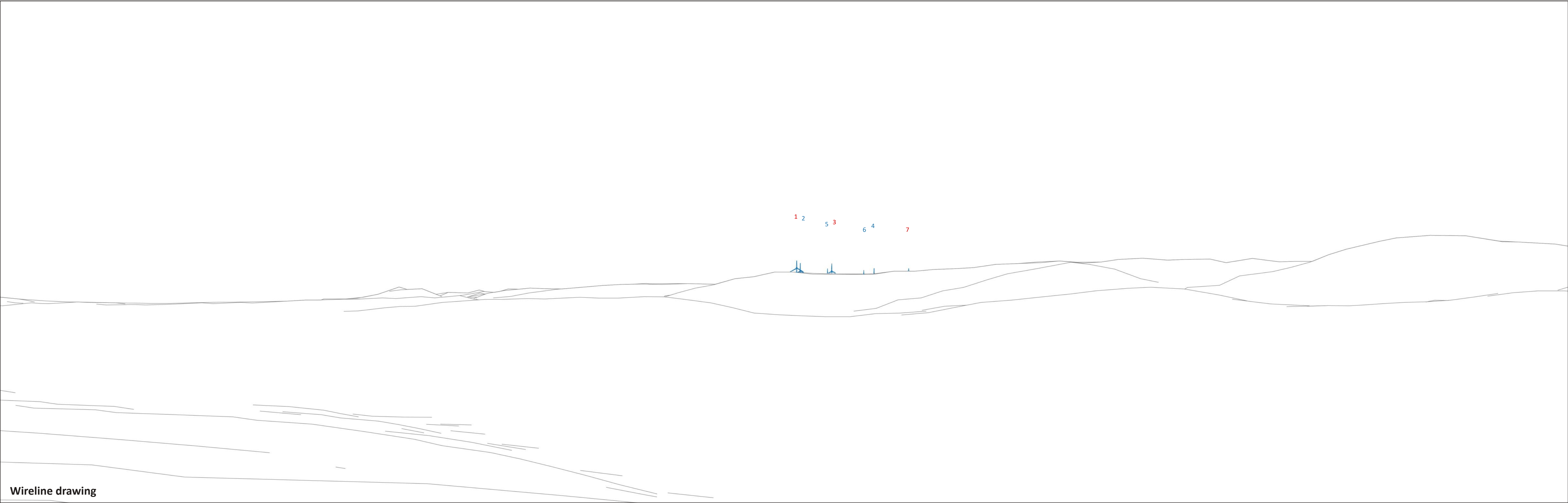
Cumulative
It is likely that all or most of the turbines at Inverchaolain wind farm (depending on its final design) may be visible from this viewpoint, seen behind the Proposed Development.
