Existing View


The views to the north and west, which are the main outlook from this location, are very varied including nearby tall buildings, the firth and its associated ports and shipping traffic, coastal settlements on the far shores and farmland and hills beyond.

Predicted Change

The Proposed Development would be seen on the open skyline above Dunoon, with some of the turbine bases being set in front of more distant hills beyond. At night all three of the turbine lights would be visible, adding to the panorama of lights seen in nearby buildings and along the coastline, and looking across the water to lights in the distant coastal villages and towns.

Cumulative

It is likely that all or most of the turbines at Inverchaolain wind farm (depending on its final design) may be visible from this viewpoint, seen to the left of the Proposed Development.
