Existing View


This view looks out from the coast at Wemyss Bay. The nearby open space, road and car parking backed by trees looking inland and the eye is naturally drawn out across the water, with the main focus being the longer views out to the islands. The Site can be seen peripherally to the north-west above Dunoon.

Predicted Change

The proposed turbines would be seen on the open skyline above the forestry and Dunoon. At night all three of the turbine lights would be visible, seen above the streetlights and lights in buildings seen looking towards Dunoon and in the context of lights in nearby homes.




It is likely that all or most of the turbines at Inverchaolain wind farm (depending on its final design) may be visible from this viewpoint, seen to the left of the Proposed Development.


