

Construction of the Soay Solar Farm and Greener Grid Park is progressing according to timetable. When completed, the project will generate renewable electricity equivalent to the needs of 18,500 homes* and reduce the UK's reliance on fossil fuels.

Site Update

Construction to prepare for installation of battery units is contained to a relatively small area of the site.

Works have involved removing topsoil and receiving stone and gravel to the site. Vehicle movements to the site will be reducing over the summer months. We would like to thank you for your patience during this time, and we will continue to minimise any disruption to local roads where possible.



Replacing topsoil with crushed stone to support the battery foundations. Temporary drainage systems including swales and attenuation ponds have been installed to control surface water runoff rates during construction.



We've listened to our Community Liaison Group and have extended our road sweeping into Thornton, keeping local roads clean.
